





Current Research provided us several important approaches for leopard conservation and management in North Khorasan province. Additional to the objectives of this research, we also used current results to develop a study for distribution modeling of the Persian leopards in whole the country. We also identified local persons who are willing to conserve wildlife species in their area. Some local persons were trained and assisted us during the current research. Later on we embarked on facilitating establishment of groups of local communities in North Khorasan province who are willing to save Persian leopard and its main preys in their area.
